

## Immigration Medical Exam Information

The immigration medical exam is one of the requirements of the U.S. Department of Citizenship and Immigration Services (USCIS) for granting an adjustment of immigration status. Only a doctor designated by USCIS as a “Civil Surgeon” can perform this medical examination.

Our Civil Surgeon is Dr. Deeni De La Rosa, who also had to go through this process. Dr. De La Rosa will answer all your questions during your visit and guide you step by step, just as she would have wished the Civil Surgeon who attended her had done.

This visit consists of a complete medical history for each applicant, a full physical examination, laboratory tests (which vary depending on each person’s age and risk factors), and, if necessary, vaccines will also be administered. The initial appointment lasts approximately 1 hour per patient.

Laboratory tests are blood tests and, in some cases, urine or skin tests as well. When the Civil Surgeon receives the results (generally about a week later), if everything is normal, they will complete and sign Form I-693 and contact the applicant to review a copy and take the complete package as required by USCIS. This means the process takes several days. If any lab result is abnormal, you will return to the clinic to receive further instructions and/or treatment.

The immigration medical exam ends when the doctor signs and dates Form I-693. This can only be done when the applicant has completed all required exams and/or treatments mandated by CDC and USCIS. The fastest the process can be finished is one week; the longest, provided you complete every step immediately and do not miss appointments, is 9 months.

## Costs

- Visit and medical exam ----- \$350 per applicant (does not include vaccines or labs).
- 4 people (must be family and have the same immigration case) ---- \$1,200.00
- 5 people or more (must be family and have the same case)----- \$250.00 each
- Vaccine package for children under 18 years without insurance, all necessary ---- \$100.00
- Vaccines for adults ----- the cost of each vaccine is different, but we offer very discounted prices for all vaccines.
- Blood tuberculosis test ----- \$150.00
- Skin tuberculosis test (only for children under 2 years) ----- \$50.00
- Gonorrhea urine test ----- \$50.00
- Syphilis blood test ----- \$35.00
- Drug test ----- \$100.00
- Treatment for early and uncomplicated syphilis with penicillin ----- \$50.00 per dose
- Treatment for uncomplicated gonorrhea with ceftriaxone ----- \$50.00 per dose

No health insurance can be used, except for some vaccines.

It is impossible to tell you the total price for the first appointment (per person before evaluating each patient); ALL patients need the appointment and the tuberculosis test. The rest depends on each patient's age, risk factors, and lab results. Dr. De La Rosa will not order anything that is not strictly necessary for USCIS.
